These following charts, which begin below, provide track numbers for each chorus in this work. For each track, you'll find the chorus' name, and matching page numbers for your score. Note that most tracks begin with a few bars of orientation before the teaching singer begins.

This work requires 2 CDs. On the first disc you'll find all the choral movements at performance tempo. **StudySpots™** are found on the second disc. Here the fast and/or difficult passages run at a slower tempo, then on the following track you have the same passage back at its performance tempo.
